- The problem of organizing online education under martial law in Ukraine proves the need to implement elements of digital pedagogy into the system of training specialists. First of all, it concerns the informatization and technologization of pedagogical processes based on a cybernetic approach.
- At the same time, society is experiencing an acute demand for value-oriented educational projects that complement SMART educational technologies, which open a new progressive path in the context of digital pedagogy.

- Today, we can talk about a dialectical combination of two main paradigms in pedagogical science (technocratic and humanistic), which include the content of education, the goals and values of learning.
- The combination of the technocratic and humanistic models of education should contribute to a new philosophy of educational thinking, the development of the pedagogical system, and the achievement of new achievements not only in the educational field, but also in science, production, and public life.





- The scientific-technocratic paradigm underlies modern SMART educational technologies. It aims to prove the truth in a specific scientific way, proven by experience. Its values are accurate knowledge. Its motto is "Knowledge is power!"
- The humanistic paradigm is a system of values and ideas that places the individual, their needs, interests, and development potential at the center of research, emphasizing self-realization, subjective experience, and human dignity.
- The humanistic paradigm in education focuses on the active role of the learner, which is reflected in self-management of educational and creative activities and the development of professional and axiological competence.
- The essence of the humanistic paradigm is finding the truth. The main thing is to involve the seeker in the didactic process of finding the truth. Its motto is "Knowledge is power!".



The purpose of the research is to substantiate the pedagogical conditions for increasing the effectiveness of the online learning system based on the implementation of a comprehensive model of digitalization, technologization, and humanization of the process of forming professional and axiological competence of specialists.

Professional-axiological competence - represents the motivated ability of an individual to productively accumulate the content of education (knowledge, skills, abilities, experience) and personal qualities and, on this basis, effectively carry out self-management of educational and creative activities and value-oriented self-development.

Educational and creative activity is a type of educational activity that represents a purposeful, value-oriented, motivated combinatorial activity of applicants, based on self-management, which solves educational and creative tasks and forms the professional and axiological competence of future specialists.



The three-level SMART-humanistic educational technology of self-governance of educational and creative activities is a holistic system of networked digital on-line platforms for organizing a reative educational environment and interconnected technological stages that determine the pedagogical impact on the educational and creative activities of specialists.


Stages of SMART-humanistic educational technology:
