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Family Values Shape Children`s Education Choices

- ▶ Everyone has the right to education (UDHR 26,1)
- ▶ Education shall be directed to the full development of the human personality and to the strengthening of respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms (UDHR 26,2)
- ▶ Parents have a prior right to choose the kind of education that shall be given to their children (UDHR 26,3)
- ▶ The family is the natural and fundamental group unit of society and is entitled to protection by society and the State (UDHR 16,3)
- ▶ Family as a basic organization unit of people, existed long before any state was created
- ▶ Family life encompasses various skills: respect, empathy, responsibility, emotional intelligence, and problem solving

Family Values Shape Children`s Education Choices and Success

- ▶ “Generally, he [the entrepreneur] will be the founder of a firm and of an industrial family as well” (Schumpeter, 1939, p. 103).
- ▶ Industrial family values are essential for creation of innovation, social entrepreneurship and social development
- ▶ Family pedagogical methods: One-to-One Teaching
- ▶ The Innovative Power of One-to-One Teaching; Father teaches Son, like Father, like Son
- ▶ Challenges in Higher Education are numerous; rising financial costs, academic unpreparedness, health and mental issues, AI, declining student enrollment, four years degree programs, de-moralizing and politicizing environment, faster pace of change
- ▶ Expectations in Higher Education; Students should value their individual background in the decisions they make, family values as a decisive factor for educational choice and success, and personal learning experiences
