- ⊗ **Support for vulnerable population groups**

- ✳ National and local support programs
- ✳ Institutional mechanisms and partnerships (public–private, international)
- ✳ Use of digital platforms for public service delivery
- ✳ Community engagement in recovery processes

Challenges and Barriers

- ◆ Limited resources and insufficient funding
- ◆ Social trauma and low levels of public trust
- ◆ Corruption risks and weak management capacity
- ◆ Need for cross-sectoral coordination
